April 27th is National Rebuilding Day

National Rebuilding Day is Rebuilding Together's largest annual event held by hundreds of affiliates around the country on the last Saturday in April when volunteers come together to repair the homes of low-income homeowners. Rebuilding Together Hartford has hosted National Rebuilding Day for the past 18 years. In that time, the organization and its volunteers have provided free home repairs to more than 350 low-income homeowners in the City of Hartford. Each year, National Rebuilding Day in Hartford brings together over 600 volunteers and 25 community partners.

On Saturday, April 27th, Rebuilding Together Hartford will rehabilitated 22 homes

throughout the City. This year's Hartford homeowners includes elderly individuals, disabled individuals, and families with small children. The homes are located in various neighborhoods around the City including Asylum Hill, Behind the Rocks, Blue Hills, Northeast, and South West.

The primary goal of the rehabilitation projects is to make homes safe, accessible and energy efficient. Repairs included: replacing windows; rebuilding stairs; installing handrails/grab bars; repairing plumbing and electrical issues; painting, basement clean-outs, installing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors; installing insulation; general yard clean-up; and installing low-maintenance

landscaping.
